	Students will make up to 3 different traditional oil paintings in this multi day painting class. Multiple layers will be painted on the canvas which need time to dry in between sessions. I will have students work on more than 1 painting at one time since their painting won't be completed in 1 class period. Students will also learn about color theory, composition, and different painting techniques to produce a successful oil painting. Students will leave with 1-3 classic oil paintings to take home. This class will be very low/no solvent with Liquin being the only item containing a small amount of solvent. It will be used sparingly to help speed up drying time.
